# VIII International Conference: Worlds of Labor

# XII Labor History National Conference

Researchers interested in the history of labor in all respects are invited to participate in the Worlds International Seminar of Labor VIII organized by the National Association of Labor History (ANaHT) and the Worlds of Labor GT of the National History Association (ANPUH). In conjunction with the National Labor History Journey XII, this seminar will be held at the Federal University of Santa Catarina (UFSC), in Florianópolis, Santa Catarina, Brazil, from October 8th to 12th, 2024. We welcome presentations concerning original research, theoretical and methodological debates, and assessments of academic production on labor worlds in their historical contexts.

## **Application Details**

Our goal is to bring together research from different academic disciplines dedicated to Brazilian and international labor history. Interdisciplinary collaboration and dialogue among researchers in the field are encouraged, as is discussion of the international agenda for historical studies of labor.

The VIII International Conference "Worlds of Labor" and the XII Labor History National Conference will feature round tables and coordinated sessions, as well as panels by undergraduate students. Proposals will be received for individual papers, co-authored papers or complete coordinated sessions (consisting of one commentator and up to 4 presentations). In the latter case, each paper must indicate in its abstract the session it intends to compose, but will be evaluated individually. In addition, based on the proposals submitted, the selection committee will be responsible for setting up round tables. We are particularly interested in presentations connecting research from different institutions, from different regions of Brazil and also from other countries.

### Worlds of Labor (GT Mundos do Trabalho)

Worlds of Labor GT has played an important role in the dissemination and development of the social history of work in Brazil. The GT has promoted thematic symposiums at all ANPUH national meetings and conferences since 2000. In 2010, the GT began holding its National Journeys simultaneously with the international seminar at the Federal University of Santa Catarina (UFSC). In 2012, the two events took place at the Center for Research and Documentation of Contemporary History of Brazil at Fundação Getúlio Vargas (CPDOC/FGV). The State University of Bahia (UNEB) hosted in 2014, and the events were held at the Federal University of Amazonas (UFAM) in 2016. In 2018, the Worlds of Labor International Seminar V, the National Journey of Labor History IX, and the Regional Journey of Labor History IX were held simultaneously at the Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul (UFRGS). In 2021, the Worlds of Labor International Seminar VI and the National Journey of Labor History X were held as virtual webinars organized by the Federal Rural University of Rio de Janeiro (UFRRJ). Finally, in 2022, the event was hosted by the State University of Bahia (UNEB).

## Registration

The National Association of Labor History (ANaHT) is responsible for a number of events and activities, including the Worlds of Labor International Seminar VIII and the National Journeys of Labor History XII. Applicants will be required to join the Association at the time of submitting their proposals.

Your abstract should include:

- A title.
- Author Affiliation. (up to four individuals per submission, all of whom must be registered for the event).

- Abstract Word Limit: 200 (minimum)~400 (maximum) words.
- Between three and five keywords.
- If you intend to be part of a coordinated session, please indicate in your abstract the title of the session and the other members of the group.
